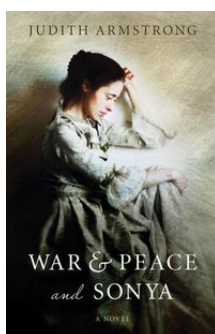


WAR AND PEACE AND SONYA
